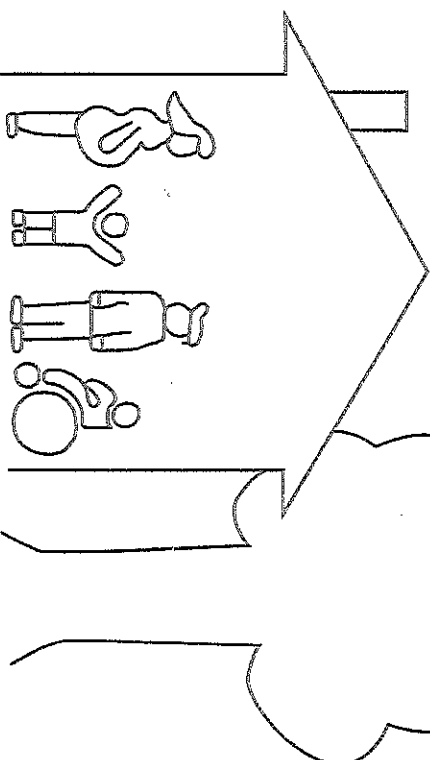

(25 years with additional needs)**

Family Wellbeing Centres support your family from the moment you know you're expecting, through pregnancy and birth, until your child is 18 years old (or up to 25 for young people with additional needs).

We work with voluntary sector providers, health and council teams to bring your family a wide range of services and activities delivered in local communities.

Most Centres will be open 9am – 5pm for now, but this will be extended to include some evenings and weekends as they develop.

### **Some of the services on offer include -**

#### **For 0-5 year olds**

- ⇒ Midwifery services that include antenatal and postnatal care.
- ⇒ Health reviews, baby clinics.
- ⇒ Targeted stay and play sessions for speech and language support.
- ⇒ Childminder stay and play for childminders and minded children.
- ⇒ And many other new activities.

#### **For 6–11 year olds**

- ⇒ Fun fitness and family cooking.
- ⇒ After school activities.
- ⇒ Family learning.
- ⇒ Applying for school places and support with transitions.
- ⇒ Young Carers group (available for 6-11's).

#### **For 12-18 year olds**

- ⇒ After school activities.
- ⇒ Education and work choices.
- ⇒ Explore the world around you, green projects, learn to be an entrepreneur.

#### **For Parents and carers**

- ⇒ Various activities for Dads
- ⇒ Advice and Information - for example benefits , housing, children and young peoples' behaviour.
- ⇒ 1:1 family support and a range of parenting programmes.
- ⇒ Job clubs and employment support.
- ⇒ Information for parents of children with special educational needs and/ or disabilities.

Activity programmes are available online or from your local Centre. These will be updated termly. Please note there may be a small charge for some services.
